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SICP Educational and RCIS Review Course Information

Through a series of questions from you and by SICP we can tailor an educational review course to meet your needs. First you should decide if you'd like this course to be simply an over all educational review course or a Registry review course with the goal to assist participants in preparing for the RCIS credentialing exam administered by CCI.

Topics that are traditionally covered in our educational review courses are Cardiovascular A&P, Cardiovascular Disease/Physiology, Diagnostic Techniques, Intervention, Hemodynamic Data, Pharmacology, Equipment and Instrumentation, and Patient Care/Patient Assessment. Your review course can be tailored to meet your needs, concentrating on each subject as needed. Enclosed in this brochure is a simple survey that we suggest you make copies and distribute to your potential attendees. It's helpful to you and to the SICP to identify the areas of concentration so that the review course is customized to your audience. If you have a topic that is not specified in the brochure, it is probable that we will be able to accommodate your needs. You will need to specify this topic when you initiate contact with SICP to plan your course.

SICP Educational Review course are based on a two day module. This can be adjusted as needed down to a one day course. Two day course are the ideal because they will allow time for workshops as well as lectures.

Courses generally cost \$10,000 to produce. Review courses that are scheduled on a different module from the traditional two days will be assessed and quoted based on the schedule. SICP can quote your facility a cost once the basic questions have been addressed. A down payment of half the total review course cost is required 90 days prior to the review course. The other half will be due with in 30 days from the close of the course.

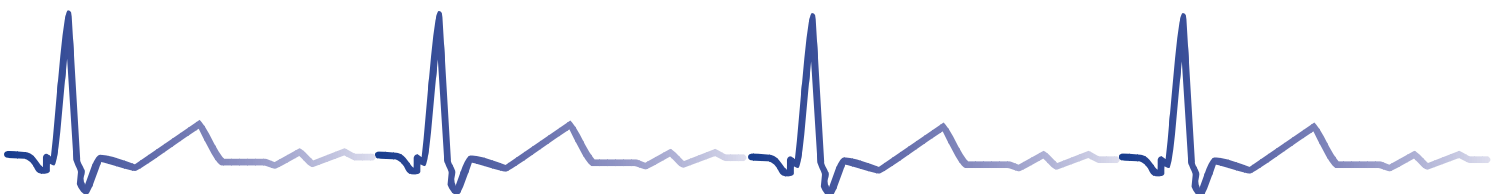
SICP suggests that you secure sponsorships from your local area to reduce the cost to your organization. Your organization should identify a point person to coordinate between your office and SICP's staff.

Registration fees generally are assessed to each participate and are based on the length of the review course and the number of attendees. The registration fee should be coordinated through the facility and SICP headquarters. CEUs will be granted.

SICP encourages each Facility to advertise the review course to other Facilities in your area. SICP will assist with this marketing effort by using space in the SICP News and on the SICP website, as well as some additional marketing methods. SICP generally likes to produce a review course for a minimum of 30 participants.
